

**John 2:1-12**

*While the sign in Cana is fascinating, and surely demonstrates the mercy and kindness of God toward a family in an awkward situation, don't mistake the sign for the destination. The sign is unveiling, little by little, the ultimate meaning of God's glory: God's self-giving, always-persevering, extravagantly generous, salvific love for the world. This sign calls us forward into trusting belief, belief that we are loved and invited to join God's redemptive work in the world. The destination far outshines the sign (Stephanie Lobdell, 2019).*

Vs 11 & 12 describe Jesus' disciples coming to faith in Him. The time spent together in Capernaum, were no doubt times of conversation and reflection. God speaks to our hearts when we spend time with Him; consider His words and activities; and allow His Spirit to shape us into His likeness.
