**Luke 4:14-21**

*The time of God's Holy Spirit is today, right now. It is the Holy Spirit speaking when you hear God whisper to you: "Child of God, live this day as if it were your first day, as if it were your last day, as if it were your only day (Walter J. Burghardt, 1990).*

*Luke places the Nazareth visit first because it is first, not chronologically but programmatically. That is to say this event announces Who Jesus is, of what His ministry consists, what His church will be and do, and what will be the response to both Jesus and the church (Fred Craddock, 1990).*

*Luke says the people 'were astonished at the words of sheer grace that were coming out of His moth'. Some have understood this to simply mean, 'they were astonished at what a good speaker He was'. But it seems more likely Luke means 'they were astonished He was speaking about God's grace—grace for everyone, including the nations—instead of grace for Israel and fierce judgment for everyone else'. That fits perfectly with what was to follow (N.T. Wright, 2004).*
